Scholar-in-Residence: Rabbi Dr Lisa Grushcow

Thursday 25 - Saturday 27 February



Alyth is delighted to welcome Rabbi Lisa Grushcow, senior rabbi of Temple Emanu-El-Beth Sholom, the Reform congregation of Montreal. Ordained at HUC-JIR, where she was a Wexner Graduate Fellow, she also earned her M.Phil. and D.Phil. from Oxford University, where she studied as a Rhodes Scholar. She is the author of Writing the Wayward Wife: Rabbinic Interpretations of Sotah (the ritual of the woman suspected of adultery in the book of Numbers). Among other publications, she also edited and contributed to The Sacred Encounter: Jewish Perspectives on Sexuality (CCAR Press, 2014), and is a contributor to The Torah: A Women's Commentary.
